Dear Parent/Carer,


We send regular communications to parents/carers to ensure you are kept informed and up to date about everything happening at South Hill, as a wider school and within your child's class.


### **Email communication**

## Class Dojo app

Class teachers send regular year group or class updates via our communication app 'Class Dojo'. This is an excellent platform which allows our teaching staff to send reminders to you quickly, such as homework reminders, spellings, change of PE day etc, as well as allowing us to share photos and updates of your child's learning journey.
