A child's family circumstances are taken into account when determining whether or not they qualify for Pupil Premium and free school meals. To be eligible, the family must be receiving one or more of the following benefits:

Income support

Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance

Income-based Employment and Support Allowance

Support as a result of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999

Pension Credit

Child Tax Credit

Working Tax Credit

Universal Credit (If a household is earning less than £7,400 per year)
