<u> Class News – Sycamore</u>

Year six have been learning to simplify and calculate ratios this week. Ratio shows how much of one thing there is compared to another and is written in the form a:b. The children are great at simplifying fractions so they have used this skill to help them simplify ratios. If you are making orange squash and you mix one part orange to four parts water, then the ratio of orange to water will be 1:4. The order in which a ratio is stated is important. Changing the order of the numbers in a ratio changes the proportions.

Class News - Owls

We have had a great week of learning in Owls. Particularly around books! As well as it being World Book Day, the children have created their own class



book featuring their very own dragon. We described our dragons using expanded noun phrases and exclamation sentences! We also enjoyed our trip to Laureate Academy for a muti-sport tournament.

Class News - EYFS

Our very own superhero, Tom the Lollipop Man, came to visit EYFS this week. The children listened avidly as he described his job, his uniform, and his superpower of stopping cars to save



lives. As part of our Communication and Language learning, we are focusing on how to ask questions. The children practiced and prepared some very good questions for Tom and the EYFS team were very proud of their lovely manners. Hopefully they learnt how to cross the road safely too.

This week in Reception we are exploring the concept of Whole, Part, Part. This means how a whole number can be split into 2 or more parts. It is important



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foundational knowledge for all future computations. The children have been experiencing practical lessons, using manipulatives such as Numicon to investigate how 10 can be made from



other numbers, using only 2 pieces. Tricky learning but they have enjoyed the challenge and progressed very well.

The day started with a whole school assembly, where the children celebrated books and saw what others were wearing. This was followed with different activities in class.
