Features of a playscript

- List of cast or characters
- Scene heading
- · Brief stage directions to set the scene
- · List of props/ scenery needed
- Speakers' names on left side (plus :)
- Dialogue next to speaker's name- no speech marks
- · Stage directions in brackets showing speaker how to say their lines or to show what should happen while they speak

Maths Corner - Maple

In Maths this week we have started to look at fractions of auantities. To help us with this we have been using counters and thinking about dividing the counters into the relevant number of groups. This lets us visibly see how we can find a fraction of a quantity. Our focus has been $\frac{1}{2}$, $\frac{1}{3}$ and $\frac{1}{4}$.
